- Abstract Submission (for presentation only): Abstracts should be no longer than 300 words and should clearly outline the research objective, research question, methodology, and findings. Abstract should be submitted as an independent word/pdf file without author(s) identity information.
- Full Paper Submission (for inclusion in an independent volume under the Lecture Notes in Educational Technology (LNET) book series published by Springer): Full papers should be between 10-15 pages, including an abstract, 4-6 keywords, main text, references, tables, and figures. Manuscript should be submitted as an independent word/pdf file without author(s) identity information.
