



FUNDAMENTAL KNOWLEDGE AND PRACTICE IN ELECTROTHERAPY FOR NEW GRADUATES IN PHYSIOTHERAPY

COURSE OBJECTIVES

In Hong Kong, use of electrotherapy (EPT) modalities is an important component in the physiotherapy management of patients with musculoskeletal disorders, no matter in the out-patient or in-patient setting.

This training course is specially designed for new graduates from overseas universities who are going to practise physiotherapy in Hong Kong. Those who are in the process of applying for professional registration, are encouraged to attend as HKPA non-members.

COURSE CONTENT

Day 1:

- Basic principles in Electrotherapy
- EPT Application Process

- Modalities covered will include: US, SWD, PEMF, TENS, IFT, NMES
- Case examples provided for hands-on practice
- Research evidence on these modalities

Day 2:

- Principles of applications for Laser, Shockwave, TECAR etc.
- EPT Application Process
- Patient safety and effective treatment is emphasized
- Principles of evaluation of treatment effects, and the application of a clinical reasoning approach to modify or progress the treatment method and dosage as appropriate.
- Case examples provided for hands-on practice
- Research evidence on these modalities
