My "can do" attitude and strong work ethic make me an outstanding candidate!

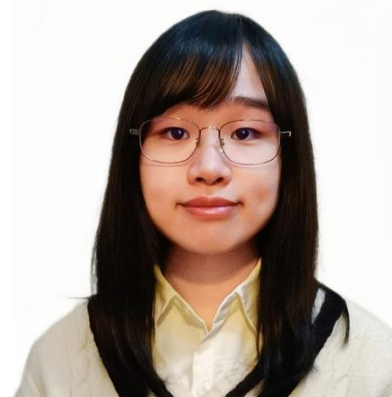
