(1) Tuition fees are normally charged by two instalments per annum and are payable before the commencement of each semester. New local students are required to settle the balance of the tuition fee for the first semester (i.e. after deducting deposit) upon programme registration in August.

- (2) Tuition rate will be locked for the full programme normal duration (i.e. five years for the five-year programmes, four years for the four-year programmes and two years for the two-year programmes). For courses taken during the extended study period, the tuition fees would be charged by a new rate.
- (3) Students are required to pay additional fees for all retake/additional courses which would be charged at the rate of the normal cohort and be calculated by the number of credits to be taken. For students admitted to senior year, their tuition fees are calculated by the number of credits required for graduation. Please refer the details in the College's Fees Regulation at http://www.twc.edu.hk/fo/student-area.
- (4) This represents the programme fee after deduction of subsidy of the Non-means-tested Subsidy Scheme for Self-financing Undergraduate Studies in Hong Kong (NMTSS). The annual subsidy for 2017/2018 and 2018/2019 academic year are \$30,000 and \$30,800 respectively. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision by the Education Bureau.
- (5) The tuition fee for the programmes under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) is the net fee paid by a student after deduction of subsidy from the Government. The subsidy for 2015/2016 to 2017/2018 academic year was \$70,000 per annum and the annual subsidy for 2018/2019 academic year is \$71,700. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision by the Education Bureau. The average fee per credit is calculated by the programme fee before the deduction of subsidy from the Government.
- (6) All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable.
