Remarks:

- (1) Tung Wah College will adjust the tuition fee of its programmes based on the Composite Consumer Price Index to be announced by the Government annually.
- (2) Tuition fees are normally charged by two instalments per annum and are payable before the commencement of each semester. New students are required to settle the balance of the tuition fee for the first semester (i.e. after deducting deposit) upon programme registration in August.
- (3) Students are required to pay additional fees for all retake/additional courses which would be charged at the rate of the normal cohort and be calculated by the number of credits to be taken. Please refer to the College's Fees Regulation at https://www.twc.edu.hk/en/Administration Units/fo/our service/student-area for details.
- (4) This represents the programme fee after deduction of subsidy under the Non-means-tested Subsidy Scheme for Self-financing Undergraduate Studies in Hong Kong (NMTSS). In 2023/2024 academic year, the annual subsidy is \$33,740. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision of the Education Bureau.
- (5) The tuition fee for the programme under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) is the net fee paid by a student after deduction of subsidy from the Government. In 2023/2024 academic year, the annual subsidy under the SSSDP is \$78,280 for laboratory-based undergraduate programmes. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision of the Education Bureau.
- (6) The tuition fee for the programme under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) is the net fee paid by a student after deduction of subsidy from the Government. In 2023/2024 academic year, the annual subsidy under the SSSDP is \$39,140 for laboratory-based sub-degree programmes. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision of the Education Bureau.
- (7) The tuition fee for the programme under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) is the net fee paid by a student after deduction of subsidy from the Government. In 2023/2024 academic year, the annual subsidy under the SSSDP is \$44,950 for non-laboratory-based undergraduate programmes. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision of the Education Bureau.
- (8) The programme is subsidized by the Social Welfare Department (SWD). Upon fulfilment of the SWD's reimbursement requirements, the corresponding subsidy amount will be reimbursed to students via the College.
- (9) All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable.
