Constitution of the Tung Wah College Students' Association

Appendix One: Regulations for the Election of the Executive Committee (Effective 1 September 2023)

- 1. A committee of 3 to 5 members shall be appointed by the current Executive Committee to form an Election Committee, responsible for handling the election of the next Executive Committee.
- 2. In the event of vacancies or special circumstances, the Head of Student Affairs may, based on actual conditions, appoint 3 to 5 members to form an Election Committee or designate staff from the Student Affairs Office to carry out the relevant tasks.
- 3. The election system of this association shall be conducted in the manner of a cabinet election, with the number of candidates for the cabinet being no fewer than five and no more than thirteen.
- 4. If there is only one candidate cabinet, that cabinet must receive more than half of the total votes in order to be elected. If there are two or more candidate cabinets, the cabinet with the most affirmative votes may be elected.
- 5. Voting must be conducted with participation from at least one-tenth of the total basic members for the election to be valid.
- 6. The election results must be submitted to the Head of Student Affairs for verification and approval; only the winning cabinet shall be officially elected.
- 7. If there are insufficient voters, insufficient trust votes, or if the Head of Student Affairs does not approve, resulting in no cabinet being elected, the Head of Student Affairs may, according to the provisions of point 2 above, reconduct the election or appoint an interim executive committee in accordance with Chapter Eight of the constitution.
- 8. The term of the cabinet elected through re-election shall expire on the nearest 31 March.
- 9. If there are any inadequacies in these regulations, they may be amended under the guidance of the Head of Student Affairs, with approval from the Head of Student Affairs to take effect.

10. Members who have suggestions for amendments to these regulations may submit them to the Joint Union, which shall take effect upon approval by the Student Affairs Committee.
