## Programme Objectives

- To develop students' competence in health promotion, maintenance and restoration, and prevention of illness through the delivery of primary, secondary and tertiary health care in various hospital and community settings;
- To equip students with problem-solving and clinical reasoning skills;
- To equip students with effective communication skills for the delivery of individualized care as well as for the facilitation of teamwork;
- To provide students with experiential learning opportunities to facilitate the integration of theory and practice in their chosen profession; and
- To nurture students' all-roundness by expanding students' understanding and appreciation of other cultures and environment.

## Programme-Specific Requirements

- Preference will be given to applicants who have obtained Level 4 or above in English Language in HKDSE.
- Only applicants who have taken elective subjects under Category A will be considered.
- Applicants should be fluent in written English and Chinese, and in oral English and Cantonese.

## Admission Requirements

For Year 1 entry, applicants should meet one of the following requirements:

- Have obtained Level 3 in Chinese Language and English Language<sup>^</sup> and Level 2 in Mathematics and Liberal Studies plus one Elective/Applied Learning Subject at Level 2 ("3322+2") in HKDSE; OR
- Have passes in AS Use of English and AS Chinese Language & Culture plus one AL subject/two AS subjects in HKALE and have passed five subjects in HKCEE including Chinese Language, English Language and one science subject (Biology/ Human Biology/ Chemistry/ Mathematics/ Physics) with at least Grade C in any one of them; OR
- Have passes in AS Use of English and AS Chinese Language & Culture plus one AL subject/two AS subjects in HKALE and have obtained Level 2 for Chinese Language and English Language, passed one science subject (Biology/Human Biology/Chemistry/Mathematics/Physics) and two other subjects, with at least Grade C in any one of the them (or Level 3 for Chinese Language/English Language); OR
- Equivalent qualifications.

<sup>^</sup> Students with HKDSE English Language results at Level 3 or below are required to complete non-credit bearing English enhancement course(s) in the first year of study.

For senior year entry, applicants should meet one of the following requirements:

- Have completed an Associate Degree Programme (AD) or Higher Diploma Programme (HD) of the relevant subject/discipline; OR
- Have obtained equivalent qualifications.

Students admitted to the Senior Year may be required to satisfactorily complete some bridging courses. The bridging courses can be Discipline courses or General Education courses offered in the first two years of the curriculum.

## Career Prospects & Further Studies

- Graduates can start their careers in **health and social care areas**, including hospital and community settings.
- In **hospital**, graduates can work at **acute and non-acute units** such as the emergency department, operating room, paediatrics, medical and surgical units.
- In the community setting, graduates can contribute to **residential care services** such as care of the elderly and care of the disabled. They can also work at **family and child clinics, outpatient departments, ambulatory day-care centres**, etc.
- Graduates who wish to have career advancement as an **advanced practice nurse, nurse consultant, nurse manager, academic faculty member, researcher**, etc. may **pursue postgraduate studies** in various areas such as master or doctoral degree in education, nursing, public health, social science, health service management, etc.

\* The tuition fee for the programme under the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP) is the net fee paid by a student after deduction of subsidy from the Government. In 2023/24 academic year, the annual subsidy under the SSSDP is \$78,280 for laboratory-based undergraduate programmes. The annual subsidy amount may vary in each academic year subject to the decision by the Education Bureau.
