<p><b>Minimum Admission Requirements</b></p>	<p>Applicants applying for the first year of the Programme must satisfy the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Have obtained Level 3 in Chinese Language and English Language and Level 2 in Mathematics and Liberal Studies plus one Elective/Applied Learning Subject at Level 2 (“3322+2”) in HKDSE; OR</li> <li>b. Have passes in AS Use of English and AS Chinese Language and Culture plus one AL subject/two AS subjects in HKALE and Level 2 for Chinese Language and English Language plus passes in three other subjects in HKCEE; OR</li> <li>c. Have obtained the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma with a minimum score of 28 and fulfilled the English language requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Grade 4 or better in the Higher Level English Language (B Syllabus); or</li> <li>ii. Grade 5 or better in the Higher Level English Language (B Syllabus); or</li> <li>iii. Grade 4 or better in the Higher or Standard Level English Language (A1 or A2 Syllabus); or</li> <li>iv. Grade 4 or better in the Standard Level English – Text and Performance; or</li> <li>v. Grade 4 or better in the Standard Level English – Literature and Performance (A1 syllabus); OR</li> </ul> </li> <li>d.
