# Towards a Quality Private University

## 學院邁向升格為優質私立大學

### About TWC

Tung Wah College (TWC) is a self-financing degree-granting tertiary institution incorporated in 2010 by the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs). Taking advantage of the acknowledged strengths and expertise of TWGHs in medical and health, education, and social services, TWC aspires to become a renowned privately-funded university, recognised for high quality programmes focusing on practical application for both for-profit and non-profit organisations, while nurturing students to be caring citizens with a sense of social responsibility.

TWC is an approved post-secondary college registered under the Post Secondary Colleges Ordinance (Cap. 320). All TWC's programmes are accredited by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ). Currently, TWC offers degree, sub-degree, diploma, certificate, and advanced certificate programmes in diverse disciplines through our four Schools, namely School of Nursing, School of Medical and Health Sciences, School of Management, and School of Arts and Humanities. In 2022/2023, the College has a student population of over 3,500. It has nurtured more than 5,200 graduates since its inception.

### 關於東華學院

東華學院於2010年由東華三院創立，是一所擁有頒授學士學位資格的自資高等教育學府。東華學院秉承東華三院在醫療衛生、教育及社會服務的專長和優勢，致力發展成為一所具知名度的私立大學，為學生提供以應用實踐為本的各项高質素課程，培育他們具備於私營機構及非牟利團體服務所需的技能，成為對社會有責任感及關愛社群的專業人才。

東華學院及其課程已成功通過香港學術及職業資歷評審局嚴格的評審，並已根據《專上學院條例》(第320章)正式認可為一所擁有頒授學士學位資格的專上學院。本院目前設有四所學院，包括護理學院、醫療及健康科學學院、管理學院和人文學院，提供多元化的學士學位、副學位、文憑、證書及高級證書課程。在2022/2023年度，學院共有超過3,500名學生就讀，成立至今畢業生人數超過5,200人。

## Our Passion and Milestone

Founded in 1870, the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) has been providing medical and health, education, and community services to fulfil the needs of Hong Kong society for 153 years. Being one of the largest charitable organisations in Hong Kong and a major provider of primary and secondary education for over a century, TWGHs took the first step and collaborated with The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) in 2005 to establish "The Chinese University of Hong Kong – Tung Wah Group of Hospitals Community College" (CUTW), providing post-secondary education for the first time. Registered under the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279), CUTW offered a wide range of quality associate degree programmes, providing secondary school graduates with an effective pathway leading to further education as well as career development.

With the experiences gained in offering post-secondary education through CUTW, TWGHs took a further step and established a tertiary education institution, Tung Wah College (TWC) in 2010. The College went through the rigorous college-wide accreditation and passed the Institutional Review (IR) by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) in 2010. Registered under the Post Secondary Colleges Ordinance (Cap. 320) as an approved self-financing bachelor's degree granting institution in 2011, TWC offered its first undergraduate programme "Bachelor of Business Administration (Hons)" and "Higher Diploma in Nursing" in September of the same year. Since then, the College's programmes have been diversified, providing greater flexibility and accessibility for secondary school graduates, to meet both our students' educational needs and society's needs for talents. At the same time, CUTW ceased its operation on 31 August 2013, thereby completing its historic mission.

## 傳承與足印

創建於1870年的東華三院，是香港歷史最悠久及最具規模的慈善機構之一，並在過去153年為香港市民提供切合社會需求的各項醫療衛生、教育和社會福利服務。東華三院百多年來，一直為香港社會提供優質的中、小學教育服務，是本港主要的辦學團體。東華三院於2005年，與香港中文大學合作，成立「香港中文大學—東華三院社區書院」（下稱「中東書院」），首次將其教育服務範圍擴展至專上教育。「中東書院」於《教育條例》（第279章）下註冊成立，並開辦各項優質副學士學位課程，為中學畢業生提供升學和就業的晉階途徑。

憑藉營運中東書院所積累的專上教育服務經驗，東華三院於2010年再邁進一步，以自資方式，成立一所高等教育學府——「東華學院」。學院於同年成功通過「香港學術及職業資歷評審局」一連串嚴格的學院評審，並於2011年根據《專上學院條例》（第320章）正式註冊成為一所擁有頒授學士學位資格的專上學院。學院同年9月開辦首個學士學位課程（工商管理學士[榮譽]）及護理學高級文憑。其後，學院積極發展多元化及具靈活性的課程，以滿足社會對教育及人才的需求。與此同時，中東書院亦於2013年8月31日停辦，完成其歷史使命。

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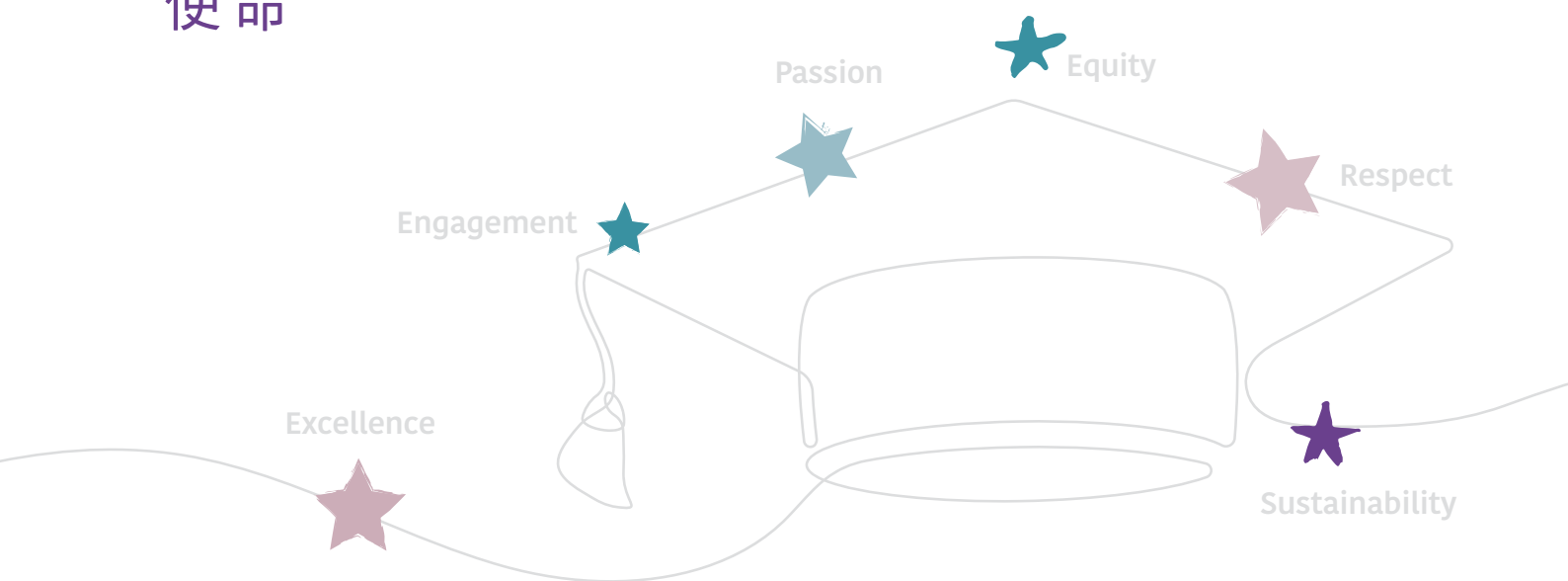

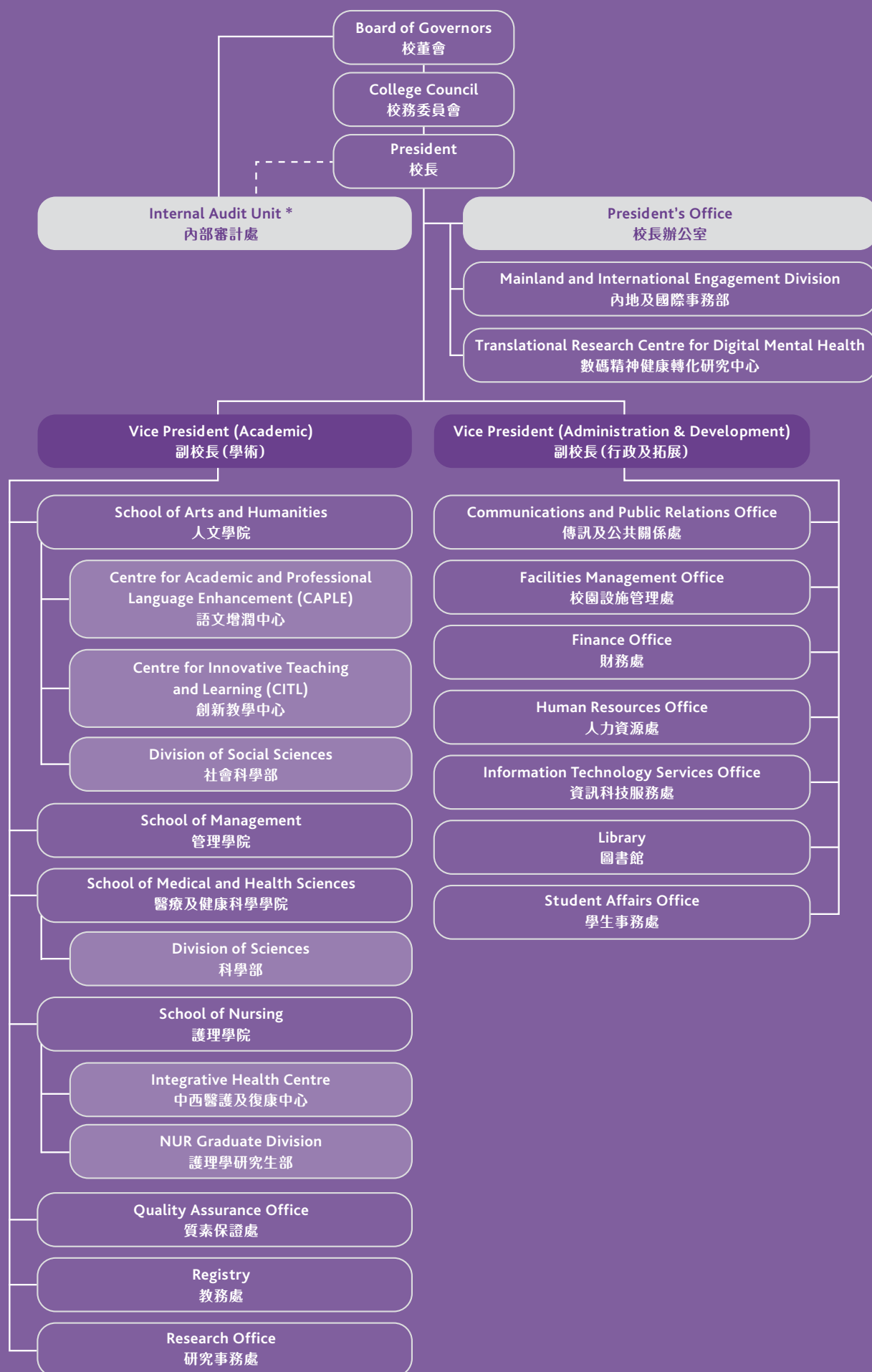



Moreover, the Social Welfare Department has commissioned the College to offer the Enrolled Nurse (General) Training Programme, attracting more talented individuals aspiring to serve the social welfare sector to join the healthcare sector. These accomplishments exemplify the exceptional quality and extensive recognition of our programmes. The College will continue to enhance the quality of its practical centric education, striving to expand the programme offerings that create value and strengthen students' competitiveness. As we enter the fourteenth year of development, I am delighted to see the steady growth of the College and its achievement of nurturing over 5,200 outstanding graduates, who contribute to society with their professional knowledge and caring hearts.

In recent years, the College has been devoted to the advancement of applied research in diverse disciplines, such as digital mental health research. We aim to uplift our teaching and research capabilities, promote academic exchange, and offer innovative solutions to society. 

## President's Overview 校長報告

The end of the pandemic marked a significant turning point for Tung Wah College (TWC). Seizing every opportunity, the College was eager to foster closer connections and promote collaboration with faculty, students, partners, and the wider community. Thanks to the concerted efforts of our College members and the unwavering support from various stakeholders and friends, TWC has achieved remarkable milestones this academic year. These include significant advancements in our development and progress towards our goal of becoming a private university, a testament to the collective dedication and hard work of our TWC community.

### Programme Development

Our programmes are renowned for their application-centric approach, offering abundant internship and workplace learning opportunities to empower students to achieve their dreams. The consistent receipt of subsidised places or funding from the Hong Kong SAR Government is a testament to our programme quality and our capability to address society's pressing demand for skilled talents, providing reassurance to our stakeholders about the value and impact of our work.

In the 2022/2023 academic year, we successfully launched the Bachelor of Health Information and Services Management (Honours) programme. In the 2024/2025 academic year, it will be included in the second round of the Pilot Project on the Development of Applied Degree Programmes of the Education Bureau and the Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP), providing 40 subsidised places. Also, the Enrolled Nurse (General) Training Programme for the Welfare Sector has received full subsidies from the Social Welfare Department, providing a total of 750 fully subsidised places for the Higher Diploma in Nursing

漫長疫情終於告一段落，標誌著東華學院的發展邁向重要的轉捩點。學院把握良機，積極與師生、合作夥伴和廣大社群建立更緊密聯繫和交流合作。通過學院上下同心協力，以及各界友好的堅定支持，學院在本學年達到了重要的發展里程碑，包括各方面發展突飛猛進，在邁向私立大學的過程更進一步。這些都是全體學院成員全力付出及貢獻的成果。

### 課程發展

學院開辦的課程一向以應用為本，提供大量的實習和職場學習機會，培訓學生成就夢想。學院多個課程成功獲得政府資助學額或撥款，反映學院課程質素獲充分肯定，能回應社會對相關人才的殷切需求，學院的工作所帶來的價值和影響力給持分者信心保證。學院於2022/2023學年已開辦醫療資訊及服務管理（榮譽）學士課程，並將於2024/2025學年獲納入教育局第二輪應用學位課程先導計劃，並同時獲納入「指定專業／界別課程資助計劃」（SSSDP），提供40個資助學額。此外，社福界登記護士（普通科）訓練課程獲社會福利署全費資助，將由2023/2024至2027/2028學年資助學院共750個學額。學院獲納入「指定專業／界別課程



programme from 2023/2024 to 2027/2028. The number of subsidised places under the SSSDP increased by over 11%, from 775 in 2022/2023 to 865 in 2023/2024, demonstrating the Government's recognition of the quality of our programmes.

We are thrilled to announce that we have received HK\$26.5 million from the Education Bureau's Enhancement and Start-up Grant Scheme for Self-financing Post-secondary Education (ESGS). This funding would support the College in launching the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Medical Imaging programme in the 2024/2025 academic year. This innovative self-financing programme, the first of its kind in Hong Kong, will equip students with the skills and knowledge needed to excel in the rapidly evolving field of medical imaging.

As an institution, we are steadfast in our commitment to understanding and meeting society's demand for talents. We are dedicated to developing practical programmes offering diverse pathways for young people, ensuring they have the skills and knowledge needed to thrive in their chosen fields.

### **Student Admission**

The College's commitment to providing high-quality education is reflected in the increase in student admissions from 3,427 in 2021/2022 to 3,542 in 2022/2023. This sustained growth is a testament to the College's highly recognised teaching quality and reputation across various sectors. As travel between Hong Kong and Mainland China gradually resumes, and with the College's active promotion of collaborations with institutions in Mainland, we are confident in our ability to attract more students to enrol in our programmes.

### **Student Development and Achievements**

In the 2022/2023 academic year, the College awarded scholarships totaling HK\$4.32 million to 196 students, in recognition of their outstanding performance in academic and extracurricular activities. Moreover, we are honoured to have our first recipient of the Outstanding Service Award for Tertiary Students. This award was jointly presented by the Hong Kong Outstanding Tertiary Students' Services Association and the Hong Kong Student Services Association, which acknowledges exceptional tertiary students who are passionate about community services. I firmly believe that through the dedicated cultivation provided by the College, our students will wholeheartedly serve the College and make significant contributions to various industries and the broader society.

### **Graduate Employment**

According to the 2023 graduate survey, the median monthly income of graduates is HK\$34,091, representing an increase of 2.5% compared to 2022. The average monthly salary in industries such as civil services, community and social services, education, and financing and business services also reached a new high. In 2023, 86% of our graduates entered

學院很高興獲教育局「自資專上教育提升及啟動補助金計劃」撥款2,650萬港元,資助學院於2024/2025學年開辦醫療影像學(榮譽)理學士課程。該創新自資課程為全港首創,將為學生裝備所需的技能和知識,於快速發展的醫學影像領域脫穎而出。

作為一所院校,學院堅定履行我們的承諾,理解及滿足社會對人才的需求。我們致力發展實用課程,為青年人提供多元出路,確保他們具備在各自領域茁壯發展必備的技能與知識。

### **學生人數**

學院專心致志提供優質的教育,充分體現在學生人數的遞增。學院的總學生人數由2021/2022學年的3,427人,增加至2022/2023年的3,542人。學生收生人數每年持續穩定增長,反映學院的教學質素及口碑在各界有目共睹。隨著香港與內地逐步恢復正常通關,及學院積極推動與內地院校的合作,我們有信心吸引更多學生報讀學院課程。

### **學生發展及成就**

在2022/2023學年,學院共頒發獎學金獎項予196位學生,獎學金總金額高達港幣432萬元,以表揚在學業和校外活動等領域上表現傑出的學生。學院更有首位學生榮獲傑出專上學生服務獎,該獎項由香港傑出專上學生服務協會和香港學生事務協會聯合主辦,旨在表揚積極參與社會服務的傑出大專學生。我深信在學院用心培育下,我們的學生會熱心服務學院,並為各行業以至廣大社會作出貢獻。

### **畢業生就業前景**

2023年畢業生的就業調查顯示,畢業生月入中位數為港幣\$34,091,相比2022年上升約2.5%。從事公共服務、社區服務、

the medical and healthcare sector, while 94% served in professions related to their field of study. The statistics indicate the practicality and applicability of our programmes, which align with the evolving needs of society and the demand for talented professionals.

### Campus Development

In recent years, we have been dedicated to achieving our development goal of optimising teaching facilities and enhancing teaching effectiveness. We established the Childcare Simulation Laboratory to enrich students' clinical nursing simulation training. We purchased a Pediatric Patient Simulator and a video recording system, from the generous donation of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) Board of Directors 2022/2023. As the number of students grow each year, we have devoted a lot of effort to carrying out campus improvement projects to create more teaching space. Various renovation projects were also conducted to provide students with a more ideal learning environment and enhance the College's image.

### Finance

The College's financial performance in the 2022/2023 academic year was desirable, recording a surplus for the ninth consecutive year. The generous support of all donors remains essential for the College's sustainable development. In the 2022/2023 academic year, we received monetary and in-kind donations totaling over HK\$12 million. We sincerely appreciate the generous donations from various sectors since our establishment, which have played a vital role in supporting the College's long-term development in teaching, research, student development, campus facilities, and other areas. The College will spare no effort to raise funds and seek donations to implement its strategic development in the long run.

### Research

Elevating teaching quality is a top priority for the College. Concurrently, we encourage our teaching staff to engage in translational and applied research to enrich their instructional content and extend research outcomes to broader applications, thereby exerting our impacts on society. In recent years, our scholars have focused on research related to mental health. For instance, I led the "Digital Buddy: Digital Inclusion for the Elderly" Project to establish a one-stop e-learning platform and train young volunteers to guide older people in using smartphones, thus improving their mental health and digital literacy. The School of Nursing has been commissioned by HK.WeCARE of Wofoo Social Enterprises to conduct regular Happiness Index surveys in Hong Kong. The School of Arts and Humanities received funding for workshops on "free play" and training for parents with special educational needs (SEN) children.

The College has achieved fruitful research results, receiving research grants and donations totaling nearly HK\$26 million in the 2022/2023 academic year. The research achievements of our scholars, including myself, have garnered international recognition. The College has five

### 校園發展

學院近年來以優化教學設施為發展目標之一，致力提升教學成效。學院設立兒科病人模擬實驗室，以加強學生臨床護理模擬訓練，並添置由東華三院壬寅年董事局熱心匡助的「模擬兒科病人」及相關錄像系統。隨著學生人數逐年增加，學院積極進行校園優化工程，開拓更多教學空間；同時進行各種翻新工程，旨在為學生提供更理想的教學環境，並提升學院的形象。

### 財政

學院在2022/2023年的財政表現理想，連續第九年錄得盈餘，各位善長的鼎力支持，對學院的發展仍是必不可少。在2022/2023學年，學院共獲捐款連同實物捐贈逾港幣1200萬元。學院由衷感激各界善長自創校以來熱心捐助，得以支持學院在教學、研究、學生發展、校園設施等領域的長遠發展。學院將積極籌募經費及爭取捐助，實踐學院的長遠發展策略。

### 研究

提升教學質素是學院的重中之重，同時學院不忘鼓勵教學同事進行轉化及應用研究，以深化教學內容，並將研究成果拓展至社會應用，提升影響力。近年我們的學者主力從事與精神健康相關的研究，例如由我帶領的「數碼友伴：長者數碼共融計劃」以設立一站式網上學習平台及培訓青年義工，指導長者使用智能電話，助其改善精神健康和數碼素養。護理學院獲和富社會企業「香港開心D」委託，進行港人各類別的開心指數調查。人文學院獲資助開展實踐自由遊戲，及培訓有特殊教育需要兒童家長的工作坊。

學院在研究方面取得豐碩的成果，在2022/2023學年所獲得的研究撥款及捐助合共近港幣2,600萬元。多位學者的研

scholars honoured as the Top 2% Scientists by Stanford University, and two scholars inducted into the International Nurse Researcher Hall of Fame. These accolades serve as indicators of the substantial growth of the College's academic research strength.

### Expand Collaboration Network

After resuming travel, the College has proactively strengthened its partnership network with institutions and organisations across the city, mainland, and the world for knowledge exchanges. We successfully hosted the Positive Technology International Conference 2023, our first large-scale international conference after the pandemic, which we invited nearly a hundred local and overseas scholars to engage with participants from over 30 countries. The College management team visited mainland institutions and hospitals, and hosted visits from leaders, healthcare professionals, and students from Mainland China, signing Memorandums of Understanding or Agreement to facilitate student exchanges, research implementation, talent development, and other aspects. Looking ahead, the College will actively promote the growth and collaboration of healthcare education and services in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, solidifying Hong Kong's position as an international education hub and a cradle for nurturing healthcare professionals.

### Towards a Private University

The College is preparing to apply for a university title following the government's "Roadmap for Becoming a Private University." The College has demonstrated its capability to meet the standards for upgrading to a private university in terms of student enrolment, governance, financial sustainability, and other aspects. We are preparing to attain the Programme Area Accreditation in two different programme areas. We expect to complete the accreditation exercise by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications in the 2025/2026 academic year, fulfilling all requirements to become the next self-financing institution to be granted university status.

I am deeply grateful for the unwavering support from the current and former members of TWGHs Board of Directors, Board of Governors, College Council, staff, students, alumni, and all our donors throughout our journey. I envision the College achieving a University of Applied Sciences title in parallel, providing students with more comprehensive and flexible admission pathways, and meeting the demand for specialised talents in various industries.

究成就備受國際肯定,包括我在內,學院先後有五位學者榮膺史丹福大學全球首2%科學家、兩位學者入選國際護理研究員名人堂等,反映學院的學術研究實力取得長足發展。

### 拓展夥伴合作關係

在通關復常後,學院積極與本地、內地以至全球院校及機構拓展合作網絡,促進交流。學院主辦疫情以來首次大型國際研討會「2023正向科技國際研討會」,邀請近百位本地及海外學者,與遍及30多個國家的參加者交流;學院團隊亦多次前往內地院校及醫院考察,及接待到訪學院的內地領導、醫護人才與師生,簽訂合作備忘錄或協議,促進學生交流、科研落地、人才培養等多方發展。未來學院將積極推動粵港澳大灣區醫療服務教育的發展和合作,為香港成為國際教育樞紐及培育醫護專業的人才搖籃出一分力。

### 展望升格為私立大學

學院現正循政府《成立私立大學的路線圖》申請升格大學。學院在學生人數、管治、財政等方面均已達到了升格私立大學的標準,現正積極籌備爭取其他兩個學科範圍評審資格,預期於2025/2026學年順利通過香港學術及職業資歷評審局的審批,具備所有升格私立大學的資格,成為下一間取得大學名銜的自資專上院校。

我萬分感謝沿路獲得歷屆東華三院董事局、校董會及校務委員會成員、教職員、學生、校友及所有善長的鼎力支持。我期望學院同步實現成為應用科學大學,為學生提供更全面及靈活的升學途徑,及應對社會對各行業專才的需求。

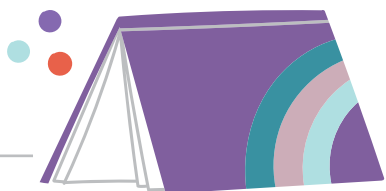

### Launch of Bachelor of Health Information and Services Management (Honours)

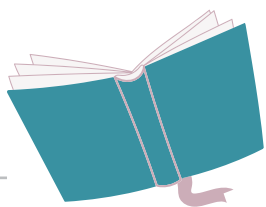
## Scholarship and Award Presentation Ceremony 2023

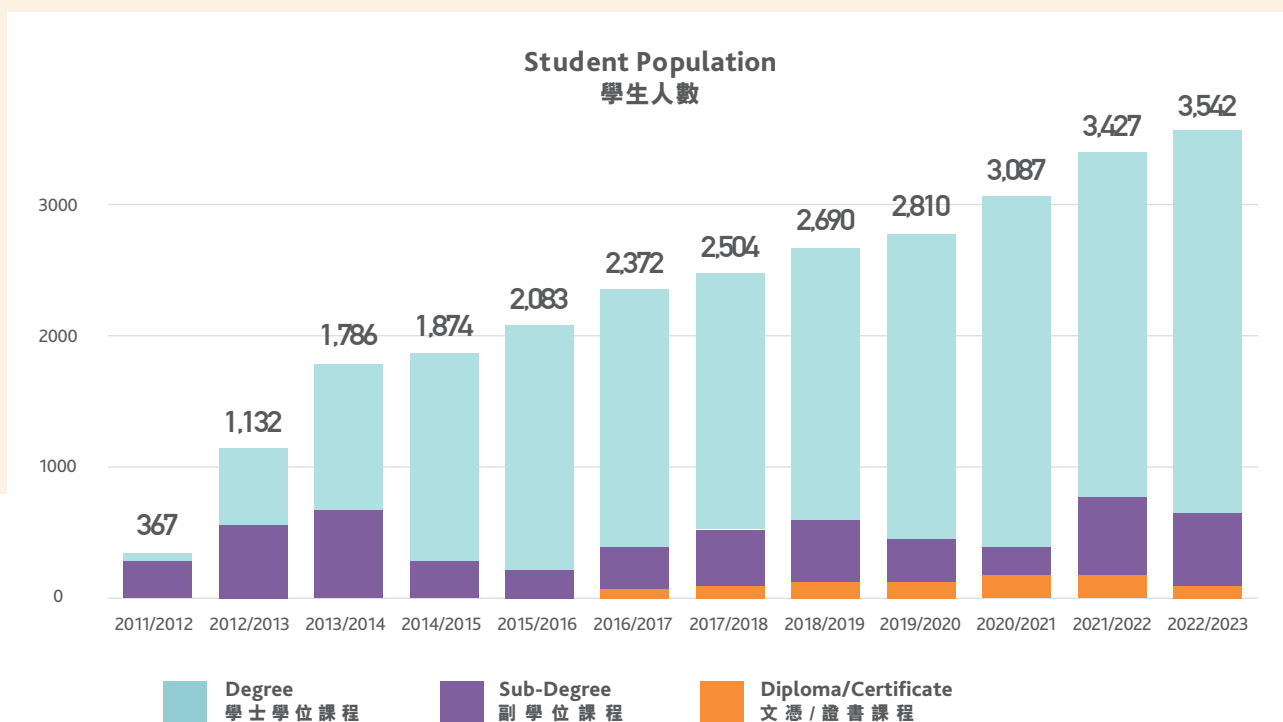

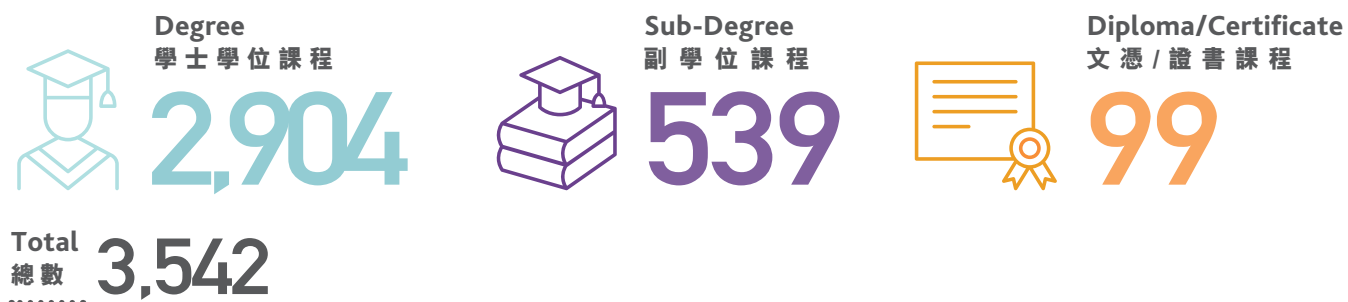

The 11/F of King's Park Campus will undergo renovation to establish the Digital Radiography Teaching Laboratory, Radiation Dosimetry Teaching Laboratory, Intelligent Medical Imaging Teaching Laboratory, Ultrasound Imaging Teaching Laboratory, and Radiotherapy Treatment Planning Laboratory. The laboratories equipped with advanced medical equipment will be launched in September 2024.

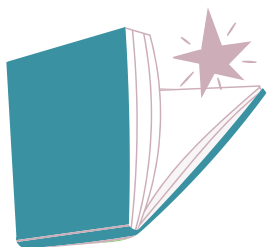

## Global Leadership & Advancement Programme

The Global Leadership & Advancement Programme (GLAP) is a one-of-a-kind advancement training programme tailor-made for TWC students. The Programme enables our students to strengthen their relationships with themselves and others, broaden their local and global perspectives, challenge their boundaries, and uncover attitudes, knowledge, ideas, and practical soft skills contributing to the advancement of human society.

A variety of training activities were conducted in 2022/2023 academic year, including the GLAP Advancement Training Camp, Life Engagement Workshops, and Social and Global Awareness in Action. Mentoring session is also a very significant component of the programme. With the continuous guidance and support provided by the mentors, students gain valuable experiences and advice to overcome their difficulties in life, know more about their inner selves, and learn to be a better person and a strong leader for the future.

The programme has been successfully conducted for two consecutive years, receiving very positive feedback from both student participants and mentors. The students had gone through over 110 hours of training sessions and at least 6 hours of group mentoring, reaching a total of at least 116 training hours.

All 17 student participants had successfully passed through the training process in 2022/2023 academic year and were honoured as GLAP Champions and Global Student Ambassadors of the College.

## Peer Mentorship Programme

The Peer Mentorship Programme (PMP) is a year-round programme providing a dynamic platform for new students (Peer Mentees) and senior students (Peer Mentors) to establish connections and develop peer support networks for mutual learning. This programme provides diverse learning opportunities for participants to develop positive attributes and interpersonal skills through training activities. With the on-going guidance and support from Mentors, Mentees can navigate the transition and integrate into the vibrant campus life.

In 2022/2023 academic year, the programme recruited 246 members, including 31 Peer Mentors, 186 Peer Mentees, and 29 Peer Advisors. ## Welcoming Day 2022

The Welcoming Day 2022 was held on 15 and 16 September 2022 at the Hall. Professor Sally Chan, President of TWC, Professor Matthew Yau, the then Acting Vice President (Academic), Mr. Felix Leung, the then Vice President (Administration & Development), and Mr. Simon Lau, Head of Student Affairs, kicked off the two-day Welcoming Day at the opening ceremony. ## College Seminars

With an aim of better cultivating the qualities of TWC graduates (Talent, Wisdom, Commitment), widening students' exposure and perspectives in other disciplines, and developing their intellectual curiosity and awareness of knowledge beyond their disciplines, TWC's College Seminar Series serves as a platform for students to meet and exchange ideas with professionals, scholars, business gurus, and community leaders on a diverse range of topics. Full-time bachelor's degree students are required to attend at least eight College Seminars before graduation to fulfil one of the non-credit bearing graduation requirements.

The College Seminar Series comprised six categories:

1) Arts and Culture, 2) Career Development and Planning, 3) Global Enrichment and Civic Engagement, 4) Life Inspirations, 5) Personal Development and Spirituality, and 6) Special Concerns. To ensure that students have access to a diverse range of seminars to meet graduation requirements, SAO consistently endeavours to invite distinguished guest speakers to address topics within these categories each semester.

As a tradition within the College Seminar Series, Professor Sally Chan, President of TWC, was invited to conduct the very first seminar at the beginning of each academic year, where she shared her personal story, the history of the College, and its vision and mission to motivate the students.

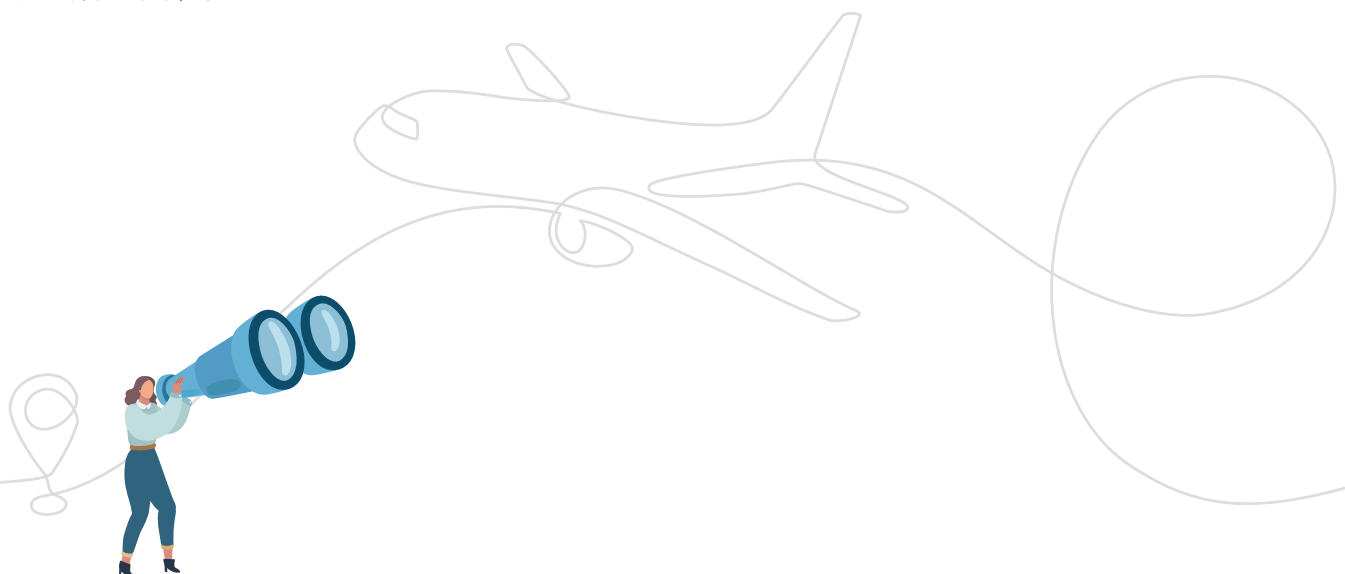

### GLAP Study Tour to Israel

Organised from 21 to 28 May 2023, the Global Leadership & Advancement Programme (GLAP) Study Tour to Israel is one of the most important components of the GLAP programme. It was designed to act as a powerful catalyst for effective global leadership development. By travelling to Israel, a country that is striking hard to empower herself through various means, students had chances to have multiple, substantive, and intentional encounters to understand global issues from a variety of perspectives. Students also collaborated with their teammates and other stakeholders to learn to address global challenges and issues.

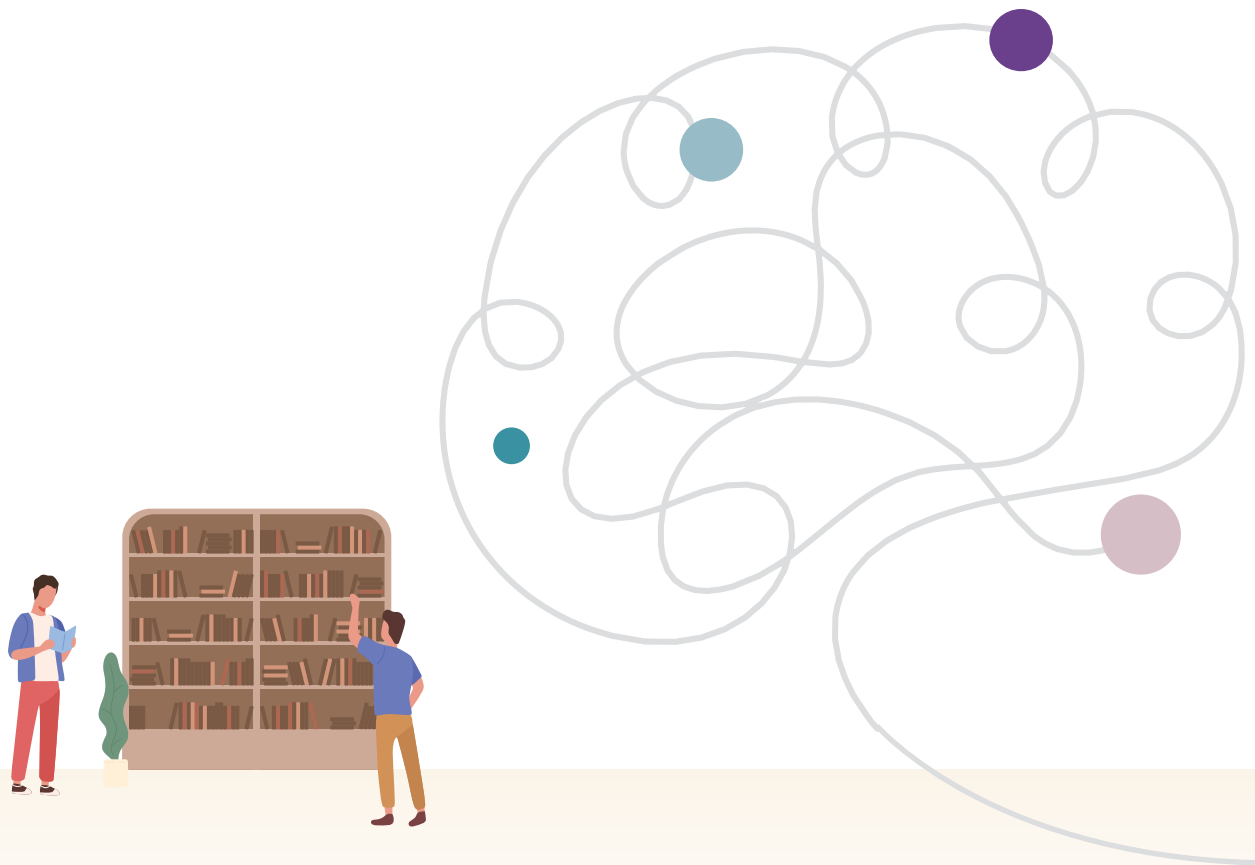

## World's Top 2% Scientists

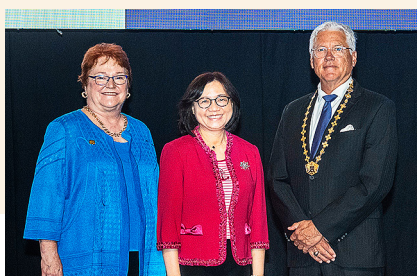

## Research Activities 研究活動

### Positive Technology International Conference 2023 2023正向科技國際研討會

TWC hosted the Positive Technology International Conference 2023 from 27 to 30 June 2023. It was the first large-scale international conference organised by the College after the COVID-19 pandemic. The Conference was supported by the Inter-Institutional Development Scheme funded by the Research Grants Council, and focused on the theme "Positive Technology: Possible Synergies between Emerging Technologies and Positive Psychology". Renowned scholars from local and overseas delivered keynote sessions, keynote workshops, and parallel sessions of paper presentations and discussions. They explored and discussed how technology could be used to promote mental health.

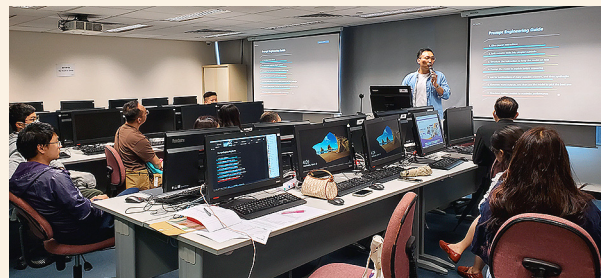

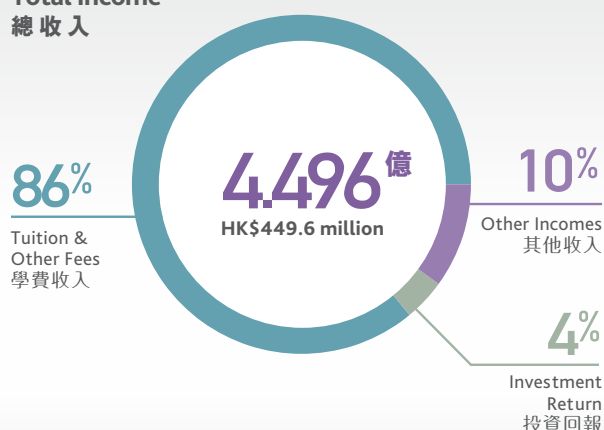

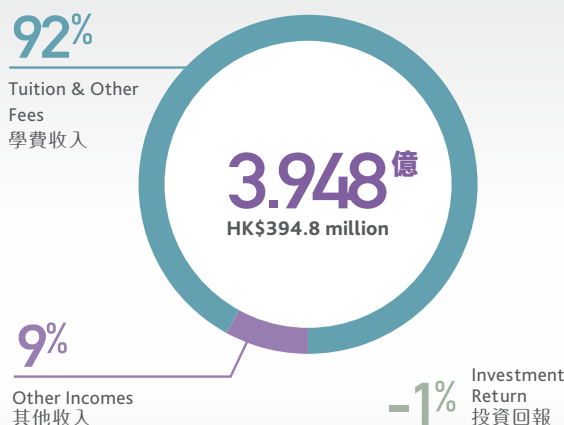

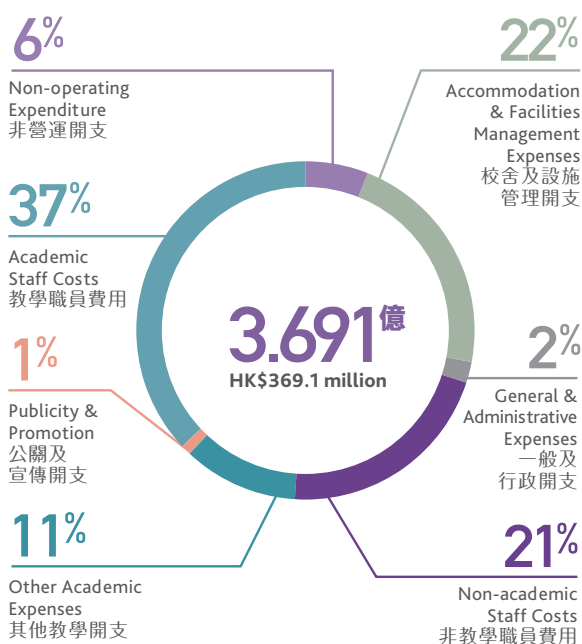
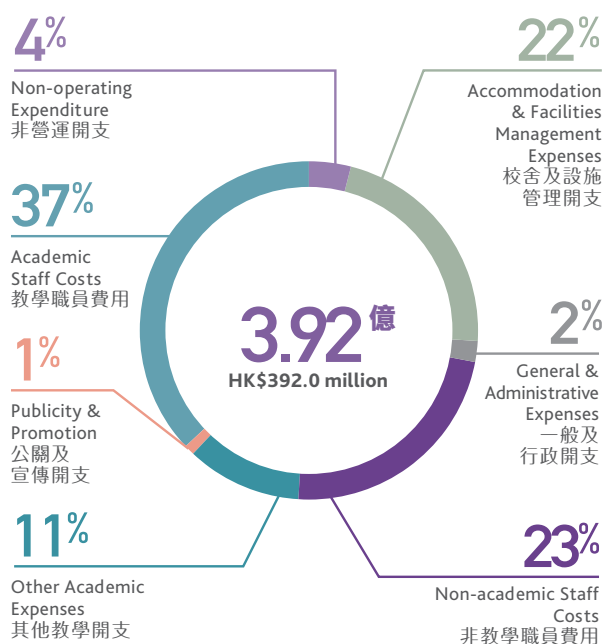
#### Total Income 總收入

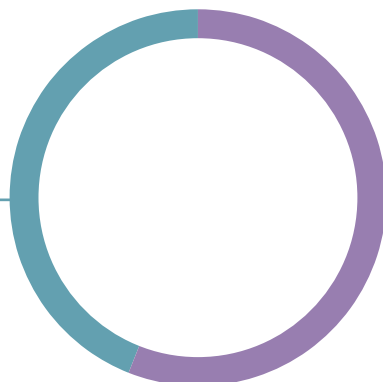

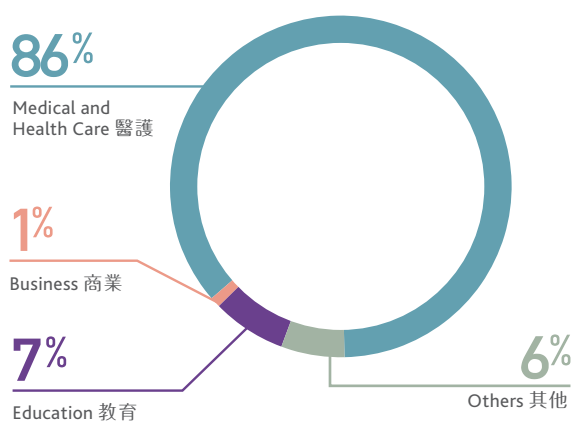

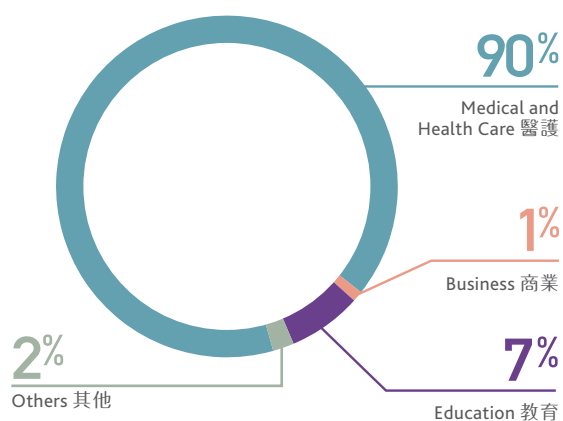


### Employment Sector of Graduates 畢業生就職行業

#### 2021/2022 年度





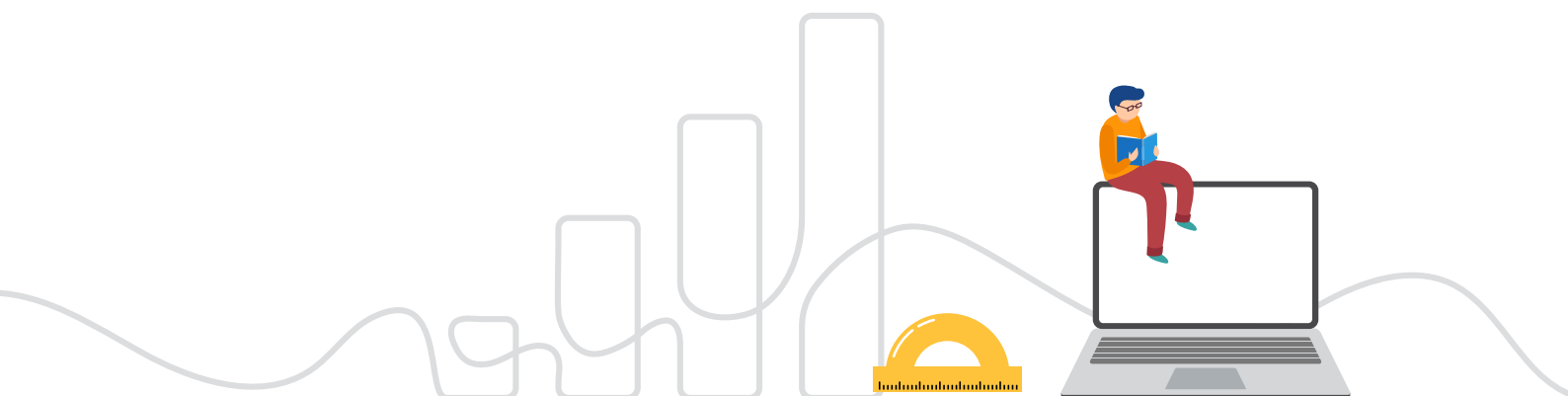

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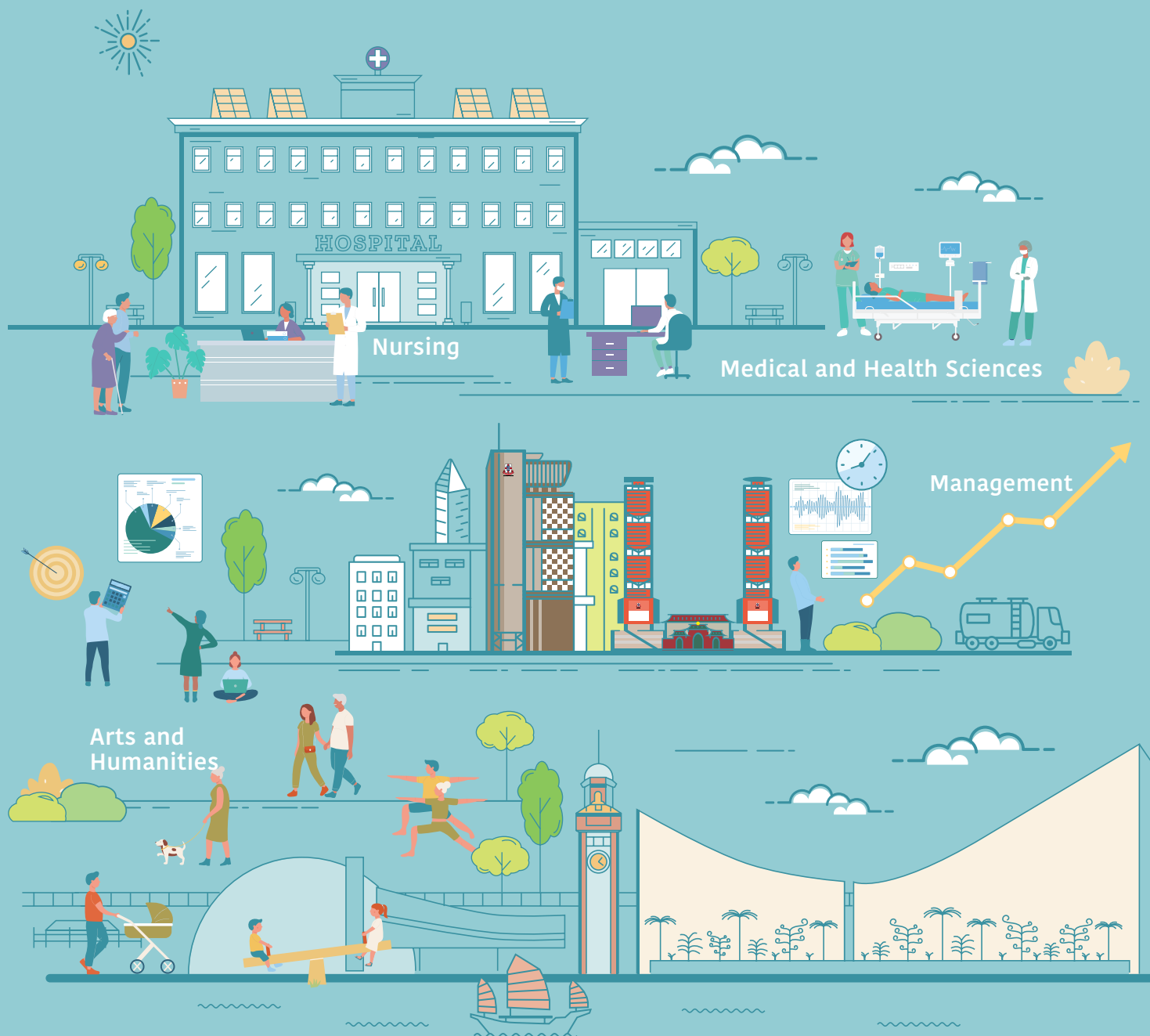
